

Licensing Your Pet

Once your dog or cat has received their rabies vaccination, they need to be licensed in your jurisdiction.

According to state code 3.2-6524, residents must have their dogs licensed. Residents of the city of Alexandria must also have their cats licensed according to 5-7-47 and 5-7-48 of Alexandria City Code. Licenses are offered at varying costs dependent on whether a pet is spayed/neutered, how many years the license is for, and whether or not the owner is a senior citizen. The license term cannot extend past the rabies vaccination expiration date.

The following are the license fees for the city of Alexandria (fees vary based on jurisdiction):
