Animal Community Spay/Neuter Assistance Program

Spay/Neuter surgery is provided at a discount by partnering veterinary clinics as a service to the community. It is offered to pet owners with an income of less than \$60,000 per year who have no other means to get their pet spayed/ neutered.

- The voucher will expire three months from the date of purchase. A photo ID must be presented when checking in at the veterinary clinic for verification.
- The fee for the voucher is **non-refundable.** If a clinic appointment is missed and/or the clinic is not notified/rescheduled 24 hours prior to the appointment time, the voucher becomes void.
- Surgeries for dogs and cats over age 7 years may require additional fees as determined by the vet hospital. These fees are paid to the clinic on the day of surgery.
- Pre-surgical blood work is required for animals aged 7 years and older for an additional fee, paid to the vet hospital. A separate appointment may be required for these animals prior to the surgery date to collect a blood sample. Pet owners pay any requisite office visit fee to the clinic for this appointment.
- Some veterinary hospitals place a small tattoo on your pet's skin to indicate that they have been spayed or neutered. Please check with your selected veterinary partner to confirm whether their hospital follows this practice.
- This special community program surgery fee includes:
 - Fluids during surgery (except for cat neuters)
 - Monitoring during surgery
 - Pain medication to go home
 - An e-collar if needed (as determined by the participating vet hospital)
 - Pre-surgery exam on the day of surgery
- The special community program surgery fee does NOT include:
 - Vaccinations
 - Microchipping
 - Other medications, such as antibiotics
 - Overnight fees if required
 - Additional care for surgeries that are complicated by conditions such as pregnancy, obesity, cryptorchidism, etc.
 - If the veterinarian determines that any of these issues apply, you will be responsible for any additional fees.
- Required vaccinations:
 - Dogs: Rabies and distemper
 - Cats: Rabies and FVRCP
